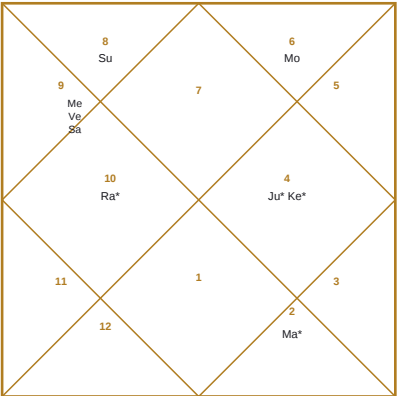

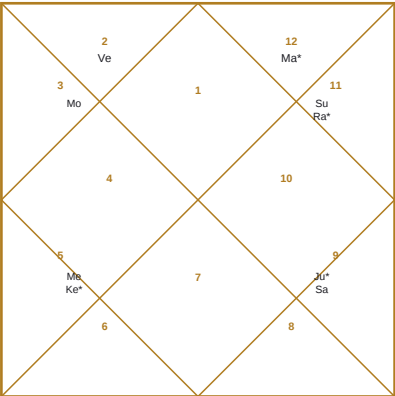

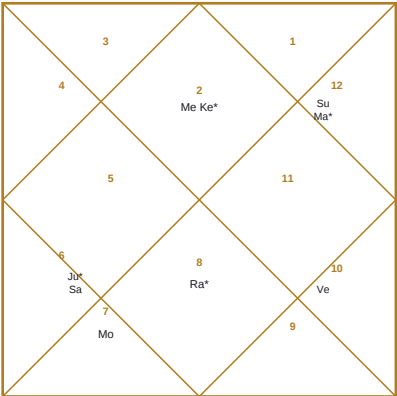
Marriage, dharma and inner strength

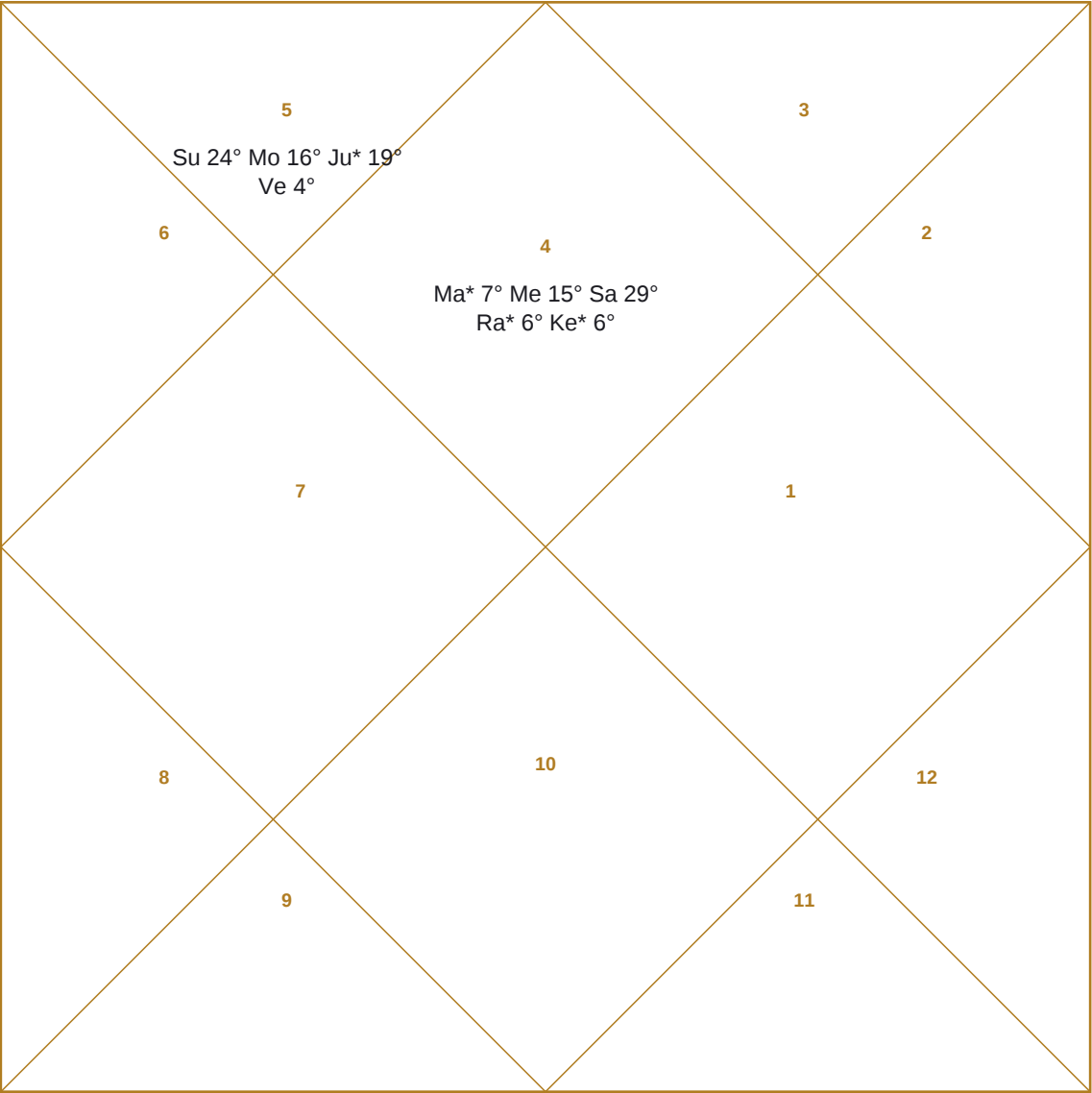
Divisional highlights - large format

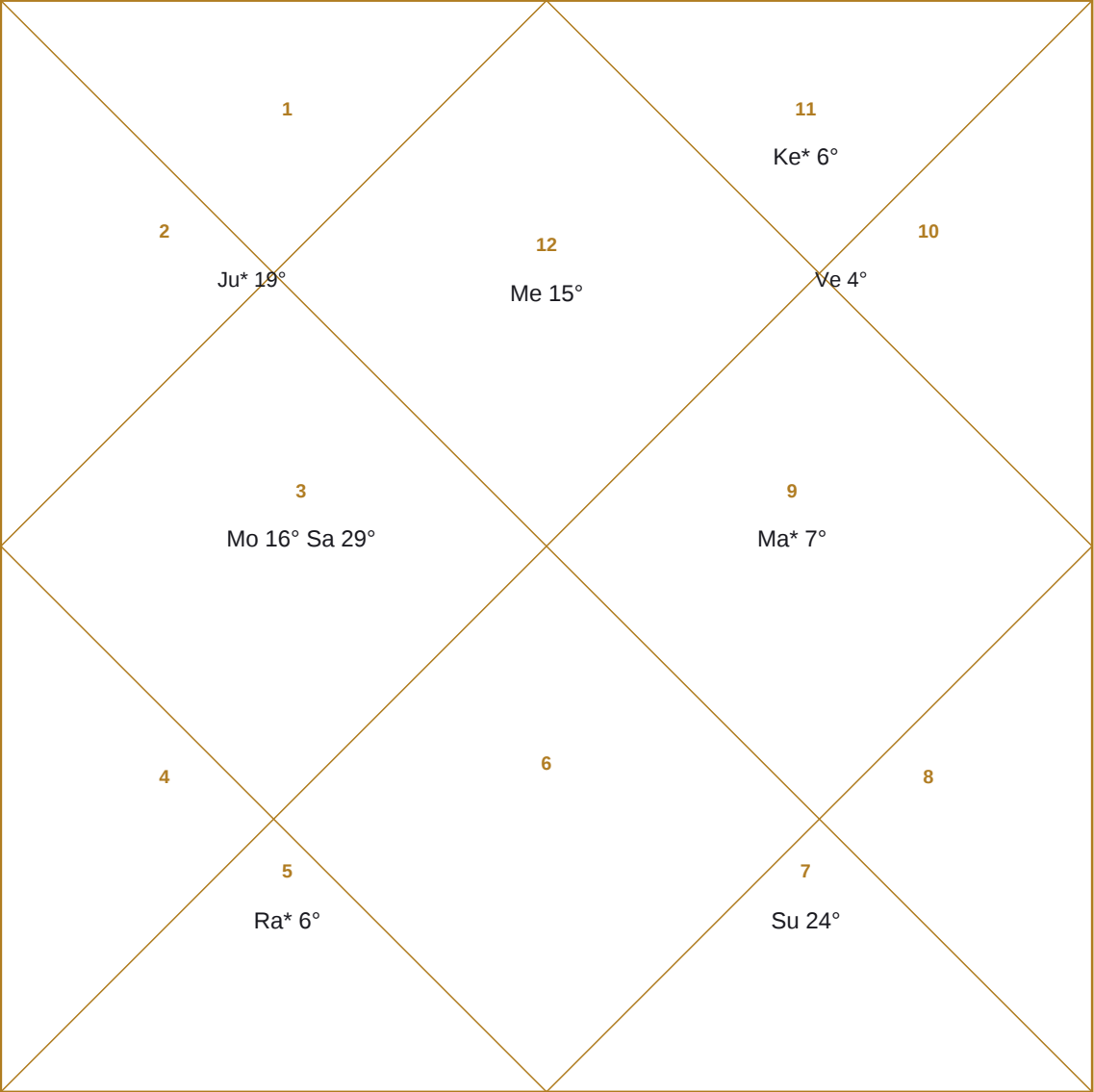

D7 - Children & progeny

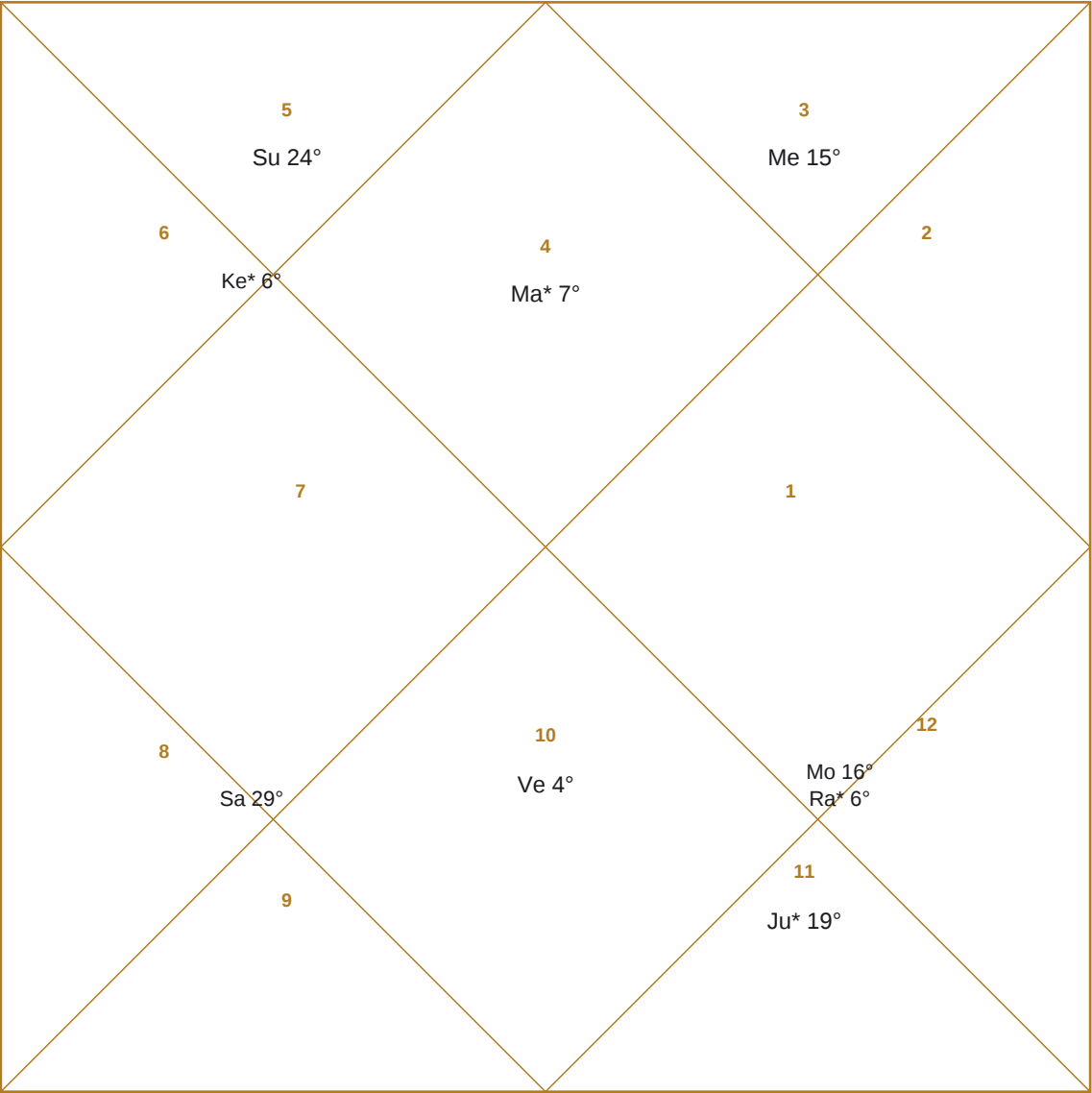

D12 - Parents & ancestry

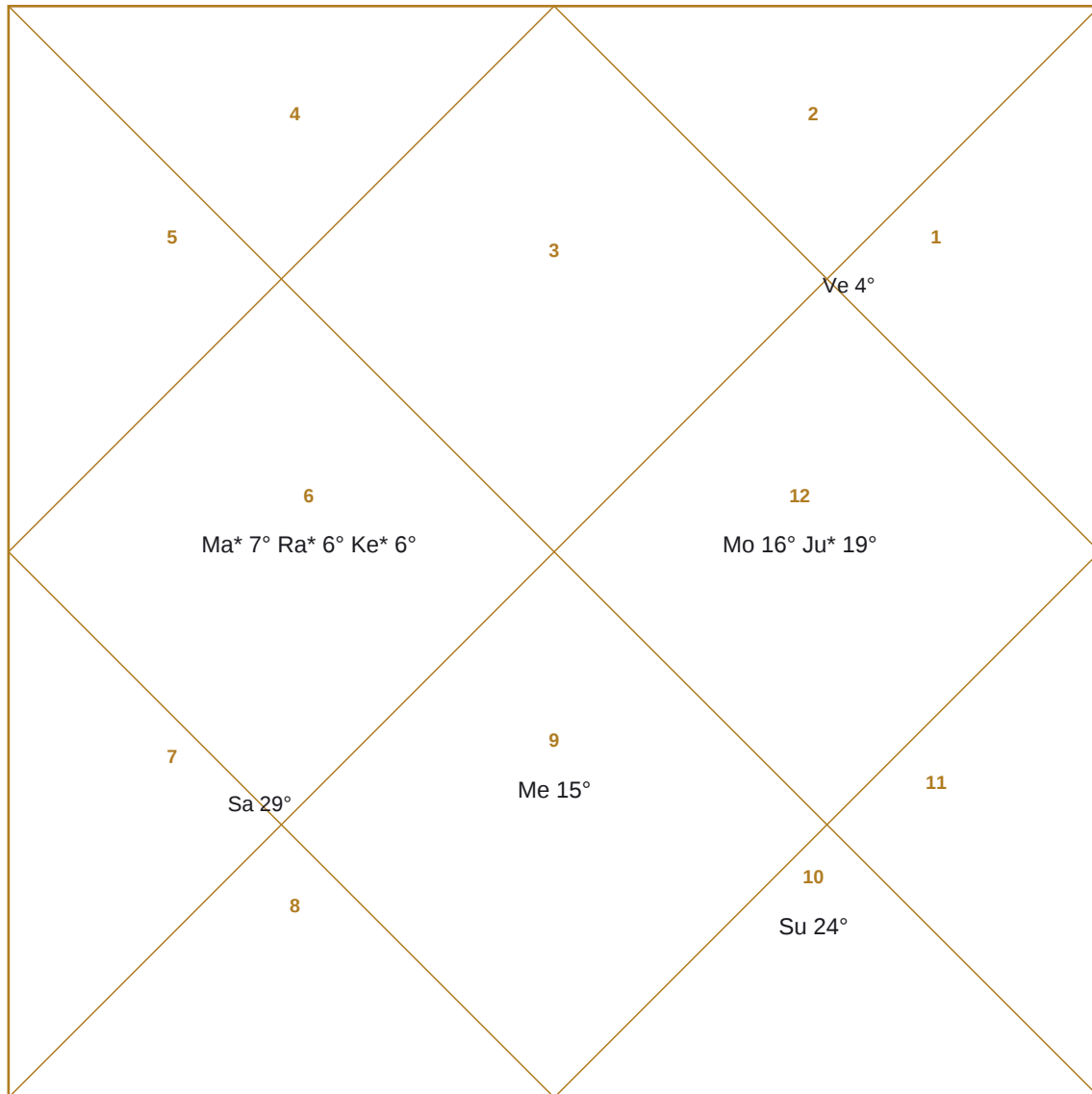
