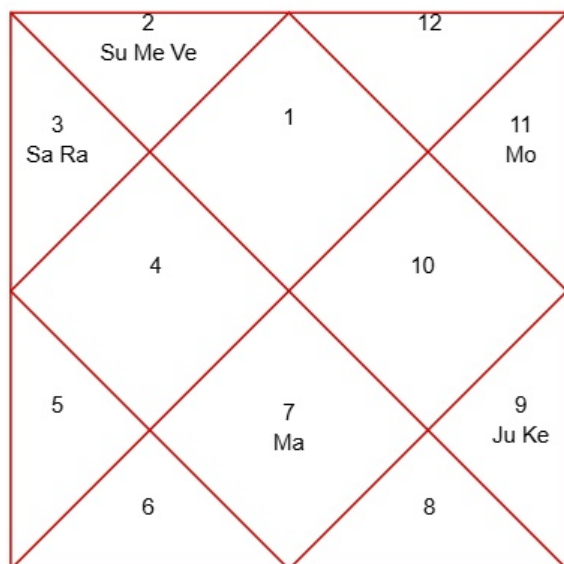

Planet readings

Sun in house 2 · Neutral · Dormant

A self-reliant Sun in the house of family wealth: the person builds savings through their own craft or skill and carries strong family pride.

Favourable	Earnings through family trade, arts, administration or government contracts; principled conduct brings lasting respect.
Watch for	Quarrels over ancestral property, especially involving women of the family, drain luck.
Signifies	soul, father, government, authority, eyes, heart, reputation
Conflict	Shares this house with Venus.

Moon in house 11 · Neutral

Moon in the house of gains gives steady income and fulfilment of desires through contacts.

Favourable	Good earnings, supportive elder siblings and friends.
Watch for	Mother's health and emotional overspending need care.
Signifies	mind, mother, peace, milk, water, travel, emotions

Mars in house 7 · Neutral · Dormant

Mars in the 7th makes marriage energetic but quarrelsome; partners need patience.

Favourable	Protective spouse and good business drive.
Watch for	Arguments in marriage, delays or friction with partners.
Signifies	brothers, courage, land, blood, energy, police and army

Mercury in house 2 · Neutral · Dormant

Mercury in the 2nd gives a sharp mind for money and speech, good for trade and finance.

Favourable	Wealth through intellect, accounting, teaching and communication.
Watch for	Neglecting sisters and daughters brings financial dips.
Signifies	intellect, speech, trade, sister, daughter, aunt, skin, nerves

Jupiter in house 9 · Neutral

Jupiter in the 9th is excellent for luck, religion and family blessings.

Favourable	Fortune, higher learning, pilgrimage and support from elders.
Watch for	Neglecting religion reduces luck.
Signifies	wisdom, teachers, father's blessings, gold, children, religion, air

Venus in house 2 · Neutral · Dormant

Venus in the 2nd brings wealth, fine taste and family comfort.

Favourable	Luxury, wealth through arts and a supportive spouse.
Watch for	Careless spending on luxuries.
Signifies	spouse, love, comforts, vehicles, cows, arts, luxury
Conflict	Shares this house with Sun.

Saturn in house 3 · Neutral

Saturn in the 3rd gives endurance and courage, but eyes and siblings need attention.

Favourable	Strength in labour, engineering and long-term effort.
Watch for	Eye problems and sibling tension.
Signifies	labour, iron, oil, machinery, servants, longevity, justice, delay

Rahu in house 3 · Exalted

Rahu is strong in the 3rd: courage, success and influence.

Favourable	Success in media, politics and communication.
Watch for	Keeping ivory items harms results.
Signifies	sudden events, foreign lands, electricity, politics, in-laws, illusion

Ketu in house 9 · Exalted

Ketu is strong in the 9th: luck, travel and spiritual growth.

Favourable	Fortune through travel and religion.
Watch for	Neglecting elders reduces luck.
Signifies	sons, maternal uncle, travel, dogs, legs and joints, spiritual detachment

Life timeline

Age 16	Jupiter matures at age 16; its house 9 themes (luck, ancestors, religion, long journeys, father's line) become clearer. Condition: Neutral.
Age 22	Sun matures at age 22; its house 2 themes (family, savings, in-laws, speech, place of worship) become clearer. Condition: Neutral.
Age 24	Moon matures at age 24; its house 11 themes (income, fulfilment of wishes, elder siblings, networks) become clearer. Condition: Neutral.
Age 25	Venus matures at age 25; its house 2 themes (family, savings, in-laws, speech, place of worship) become clearer. Condition: Neutral.
Age 28	Mars matures at age 28; its house 7 themes (marriage, spouse, business partners, trade, public dealings) become clearer. Condition: Neutral.
Age 34	Mercury matures at age 34; its house 2 themes (family, savings, in-laws, speech, place of worship) become clearer. Condition: Neutral.
Age 36	Saturn matures at age 36; its house 3 themes (brothers, courage, short journeys, hands, self-effort) become clearer. Condition: Neutral.
Age 42	Rahu matures at age 42; its house 3 themes (brothers, courage, short journeys, hands, self-effort) become clearer. Condition: Exalted.
Age 48	Ketu matures at age 48; its house 9 themes (luck, ancestors, religion, long journeys, father's line) become clearer. Condition: Exalted.

Maturity ages are interpretive checkpoints, not guarantees of a specific event.

Life-area predictions

Education & learning · Supportive

Lal Kitab reads basic schooling from the 4th house, higher and analytical learning from the 5th and wisdom from Jupiter and Mercury.

House 5 is empty: The 5th house is empty; learning outcomes are judged mainly by Jupiter and Mercury and by what occupies the 4th and 9th houses.

Jupiter in house 9: Jupiter is well placed, supporting teachers' blessings and higher degrees.

Mercury in house 2: Mercury supports analytical, commercial and communication skills.

Supporting houses: Sun in house 2; Mercury in house 2; Venus in house 2; Jupiter in house 9; Ketu in house 9

Timing: Schooling foundations are laid before 16 (Jupiter's maturity); analytical and professional qualifications strengthen toward 22-34 depending on Sun and Mercury. Watch the maturity ages 16, 34.

- Apply saffron or turmeric tilak before exams and study sessions.
- Serve and respect teachers; donate books or stationery to students.
- Keep the study area in the north-east, clean and well lit.

Career & profession · Supportive

The 10th house is the seat of karma. Saturn is its natural owner in Lal Kitab, so Saturn's condition colours every career reading.

House 10 is empty: The 10th house is empty; career direction is read through Saturn's placement and the planets in the 2nd, 6th and 11th houses.

Saturn in house 3: Saturn is supportive, so persistent work compounds into authority.

Supporting houses: Sun in house 2; Mercury in house 2; Venus in house 2; Moon in house 11

Timing: Career traction commonly builds around Sun's age (22) and consolidates near Saturn's maturity (36); the planet in the 10th sets the dominant window. Watch the maturity ages 22, 34, 36.

- Avoid alcohol, meat and dishonest earnings; Saturn rewards clean conduct.
- Feed and help labourers, the elderly and the visually impaired on Saturdays.
- Float a copper coin in flowing water before a job change or new venture.

Marriage & spouse · Mixed

Lal Kitab assigns the 7th house to Venus and Mercury together. Mars placement adds the Manglik-type considerations.

Mars in house 7: Mars in the 7th makes marriage energetic but argumentative; patience is essential.

Venus in house 2: Venus is comfortable, supporting affection and marital comfort.

Mars in house 7: Mars occupies a sensitive house for marriage; temper and timing need care.

Jupiter in house 9: Jupiter protects marriage with elders' blessings.

Supporting houses: Sun in house 2; Mercury in house 2; Venus in house 2

Timing: Typical Lal Kitab timing: Venus matures at 25; many charts see marriage settle between 22 and 28 and Saturn in the 7th often delays it toward 28-36. Watch the maturity ages 25, 34.

- Donate cow feed or curd on Fridays and keep the spouse respected.
- Avoid dowry disputes and pressure on the spouse's family for money.
- Offer sweets to sisters, daughters or sisters-in-law before marriage talks.

Children & childbirth · Supportive

The 5th house governs progeny. Jupiter is the prime karaka, Sun indicates sons in the classical text and Ketu represents offspring blessings.

House 5 is empty: The 5th house is empty; progeny is judged through Jupiter and the planets in the 9th and 11th.

Jupiter in house 9: Jupiter is supportive for progeny.

Ketu in house 9: Ketu supports continuity of family line.

Supporting houses: Jupiter in house 9; Ketu in house 9; Moon in house 11; Sun in house 2; Mercury in house 2; Venus in house 2

Timing: Progeny windows are often read between 24 and 32 depending on Jupiter's condition; Saturn or Rahu in the 5th shift this later. Watch the maturity ages 16, 22, 48.

- Offer water to a peepal tree and serve teachers.
- Do not delay family planning without reason.
- Feed dogs and donate milk to children.

Foreign travel · Supportive

Long-distance travel is read from the 9th, 12th and 3rd houses; Rahu and Ketu are the planets of foreign lands.

House 12 is empty: The 12th house is empty; travel is judged through Rahu, Ketu and the 9th house.

Rahu in house 3: Rahu activates foreign connections.

Ketu in house 9: Ketu supports long journeys.

Supporting houses: Jupiter in house 9; Ketu in house 9; Saturn in house 3; Rahu in house 3; Mars in house 7

Timing: Travel often opens after 24 (Moon) and grows strongest near Rahu's age (42) or Ketu's (48) when those planets are prominent. Watch the maturity ages 24, 42, 48.

- Feed dogs before long journeys.
- Donate a blanket to the needy.
- Keep water from a holy river at home.

Foreign settlement · Mixed

Settling abroad requires a strong 12th house and a 4th house that loosens ties to the birthplace.

House 12 is empty: The 12th house is empty; settlement is judged through Rahu, Ketu and the 4th house.

Supporting houses: Jupiter in house 9; Ketu in house 9; Mars in house 7

Timing: Settlement often follows Rahu's age (42) or occurs earlier if Rahu occupies the 12th. Watch the maturity ages 36, 42, 48.

- Keep fennel under the pillow.
- Donate barley or coconut.
- Feed dogs regularly.

Litigation & disputes · Mixed

Disputes, lawsuits and enemies are read from the 6th house, with the 8th and 12th showing hidden risks.

House 6 is empty: The 6th house is empty; disputes are judged through Mars, Saturn and Rahu.

Supporting houses: No supporting-house occupants

Timing: Disputes often peak near Mars' age (28) or Saturn's (36). Watch the maturity ages 28, 36, 42, 48.

- Feed black dogs.
- Donate mustard oil on Saturdays.
- Avoid carrying grudges.

Property & land · Mixed

Property is read from the 4th house, with Mars governing land and Saturn governing buildings.

House 4 is empty: The 4th house is empty; property is judged through Mars, Saturn and Moon.

Supporting houses: Moon in house 11; Sun in house 2; Mercury in house 2; Venus in house 2

Timing: Property often comes after Mars' age (28) or Saturn's (36). Watch the maturity ages 24, 28, 36.

- Pour milk into a well.
- Offer water to a peepal tree.
- Keep the home well ventilated.

Vehicle purchase · Mixed

Vehicles are read from the 4th house, with Venus as the karaka of vehicles and comfort.

House 4 is empty: The 4th house is empty; vehicles are judged through Venus and Moon.

Supporting houses: Moon in house 11

Timing: Vehicles often come after Venus' age (25). Watch the maturity ages 24, 25.

- Donate white items on Fridays.
- Keep a silver item in the vehicle.
- Drive carefully on Tuesdays.

Debts, conflicts & dormancy

Pitra Rin (ancestral debt)

Triggered by Mercury in house 2, Venus in house 2. Unfinished duties of the forefathers can surface as blocked luck, delays in progeny or unexplained family setbacks.

Remedy: Collect an equal money contribution from every blood relative of the family and donate it on one day for a religious cause; offer water to a peepal tree.

Stri Rin (debt to women)

Triggered by Sun in house 2. Harm done to a woman in the family line reflects as marital discord and loss of comfort.

Remedy: Collect money from family members and feed 100 cows on one day.

Zulmana Rin (debt of cruelty)

Triggered by Moon in house 11. Past cruelty toward labourers or the helpless returns as career and property setbacks.

Remedy: Collect money from family members and feed labourers and the needy on one day.

Conflicting planets

Sun and Venus in house 2

Planets that are mutual enemies sitting together tend to fight for the house's results; the house's matters become unstable until the weaker planet is strengthened through its remedies.

Empty and dormant houses

Empty: 1, 4, 5, 6, 8, 10, 12. Dormant: 4, 8, 10, 12.

Priority remedy plan

- ☐ **1. Sun-Venus conflict in house 2.** Donate coconut, mustard oil and almonds at a place of worship; avoid accepting these as gifts.
- ☐ **2. Wake Sun in house 2.** Donate coconut, mustard oil and almonds at a place of worship; avoid accepting these as gifts.
- ☐ **3. Wake Mars in house 7.** Keep a solid piece of silver at home.
- ☐ **4. Wake Mercury in house 2.** Keep sisters and daughters happy and give them gifts.
- ☐ **5. Wake Venus in house 2.** Donate jowar (sorghum) or cow feed.
- ☐ **6. Pitra Rin (ancestral debt).** Collect an equal money contribution from every blood relative of the family and donate it on one day for a religious cause; offer water to a peepal tree.
- ☐ **7. Stri Rin (debt to women).** Collect money from family members and feed 100 cows on one day.
- ☐ **8. Zulmana Rin (debt of cruelty).** Collect money from family members and feed labourers and the needy on one day.

Rules for remedies

- Do only one remedy at a time and continue it for 40 to 43 days without a break.
- Perform remedies between sunrise and sunset unless stated otherwise.
- A family member related by blood may perform a remedy on the native's behalf.
- Stop a remedy if results worsen and do not perform remedies on behalf of others during your own remedy period.
